The objective of this discussion guideline is the evaluation of competences by learner and trainer together in an open dialogue

- a) Do you feel familiar with the concept of women empowerment?
 - i) Do you think that you have the same opportunities as men to develop your project?
 - ii) What gender inequalities exist in business and entrepreneurship?
 - iii) Do you think it is more difficult for a woman to reconcile a business and career with family commitments?
 - iv) Do you know what economic violence is and how it can be prevented?
 - v) Are you aware of existing financial, legal and educational instruments in your country/region to facilitate female entrepreneurship?



- b) Do you feel familiar with the concept of eco-entrepreneurship?
 - i) Can you recognise the difference between entrepreneurship and eco-entrepreneurship?
 - ii) How would you rate your level of awareness on current environmental and social issues?
 - iii) Do you feel equipped to answer environmental and social challenges?
 - iv) Do you know of any examples of activities, shops or businesses that are concerned with the environment or have a particular focus on the environment?
 - v) How would you rate your level of interest in learning more about the job opportunities that the ecological transition can offer?



- c) Do you feel familiar with financial management?
 - i) Do you think that you are able to keep a good balance between your own incomes and expenditures?
 - ii) Are you able to create a budget to plan the incomes and expenditures of a project you want to carry out, like, for instance, your own business?
 - iii) What is your degree of acquaintance with different kinds of bank accounts, shares, bank loans, public finances (government taxes), types of investments, etc.?
 - iv) Can you recognise the elements involved in a loan transaction (interest rate, documents, bank's costs and expenses)?
 - v) Do you know any kind of local, regional, national or European funding to finance your project?
